

Meeting Minutes of October 12, 2010

called to order: 7:10 PM- adjourned 8:05

Attendance: 11 members

TRAIL COORDINATOR: Bruce Nelson indicated all funding has been submitted. He has not received the confirmation of approval. There is an issue with the Rice Creek Trail section. 2 complaints of been received. The complaints indicate the trail is too rough for riders to come from the north to the south. Bruce will forward to the DNR contact person.

OLD BUSINESS: Discussed signs, cleats and snow fencing inventory for each club.

NEW BUSINESS: Discussed the blue signs available from the DNR to post for gas/food stops on the trail. Chris Hause to check on this. The Woodbury club had damaged lawn edging that had to be replaced. Cost \$595.00 and they will put up snow fence to prevent damage for the upcoming season. Update on the Woodbury trail- Roger has worked hard over the past two years to develop new trail. He is currently working with Paul Griffin of the City of Woodbury- they have come to an agreement for re-routing the south section of the trail. Assistance will be needed to clear brush, etc. Roger to let us know when help is needed. The trail will use less streets and have more landowners. (NICE JOB- ROGER!!) The Cottage Grove club will hold their snowmobile safety course in December, more information to follow. John Udstuen didn't receive final check for grooming. John Auer to review. There is an area of the trail that may require a bridge. This washout area is approx 5 feet deep and 10 feet across. John will contact someone at the county regarding the dangers of this specific area. Tim Gardner checked on the shelter in the Lake Elmo Park Reserve. The window was pushed out, window was not broken, but a piece of the trim was broken. The picnic table requires a new bench, to replace the rotten one. Also discussed putting a solar light in the shelter. A motion was made to purchase one solar light to determine if its worthwhile to put in all shelters. Motion passed. Tim to take care of this.
